Warmer Days

In the warmer weather please remember hats and sun cream (these should be CLEARLY LABELLED). Also sensible shoes please, no flip flops as the children cannot play run around games safely with this type of footwear.

This terms topic is holidays and transport.

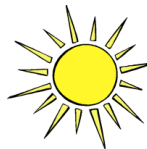


We will also be learning about the world cup.
